# Title I Program

- What is “Title I”?
  - Funds to provide programs to help children who are struggling in reading and math.
  - Extra help (in addition to what they learn during math and reading time in the classroom)
  - Funding provided under No Child Left Behind
- Types of Programs:
  - Schoolwide – all students
  - Targeted – students identified for the program based on performance on assessments

# Title I Assessments

- Assessments are used to help teachers determine if a student is understanding the content presented in the classroom.
- We use the following assessments for all of our students:
  - Basic Phonics Skills Test
  - Literably
  - STAR Early Literacy
  - STAR Reading
  - STAR Math

# Proficiency Levels

- If a child does not reach a certain proficiency level when they take an assessment, we consider them for additional help from our Title I program.
- The proficiency levels for our assessments are:
  - STAR - at or above Benchmark
  - Performance Tasks - Achieving
  - Math Expressions - Achieving
  - Literably - dependent on grade level and time of year.
